IMPORTANT NEWS FOR SEPTEMBER

- We expect all children safely back on 6 September **in their summer uniform.**
- Morning routine remains the same. Children will go straight to class at 8.45 a.m. ready to start learning at 9.00 a.m. Children need to arrive at School by 8.55 a.m. so that they do not disrupt their peers.
- We are still keeping our staggered times at the end of the day:
Nursery: 2.55 p.m.
Reception: 3.00 p.m.
Year 1 and Year 2: 3.05 p.m.
Year 3 and Year 4: 3.10 p.m.
Year 5 and Year 6: 3.15 p.m.
- The children will still be able to wear their PE kits and appropriate footwear when it is their class day.
- There are quite a few children wearing earrings. From September, these need to be changed for a **simple small stud**. Any other style of earring will need removing. Earrings are to be removed on the day your child has PE, please do not use tape.
- In September the children will only need to bring their book bags and lunch boxes.
- Children will need wellingtons in school.
- Any holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Unauthorised holidays may incur a penalty notice.
