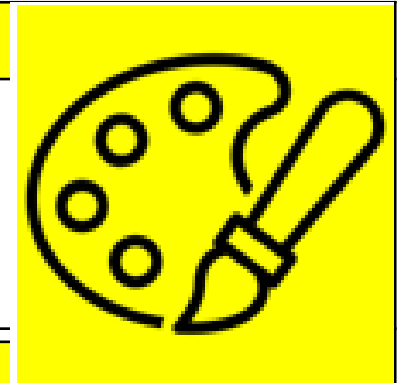




Objectives and Sticky Knowledge

Leonora Carrington (surrealism)**

1. Surrealism is a style of painting/drawing/art that has realistic looking elements in it but in a surreal setting.
2. A key theme of Leonora Carrington's was to include animals in her pieces.
3. She was an English-born Mexican [Surrealist](#) artist and writer known for her haunting, autobiographical paintings.

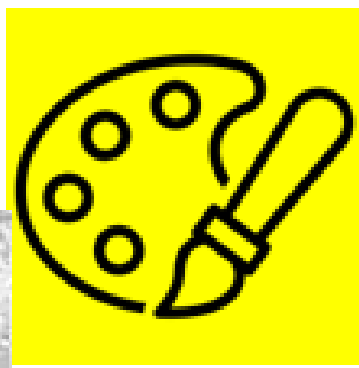

She found refuge in art, and in 1936 she enrolled in new art academy founded by painter Amédée Ozenfant in London.
