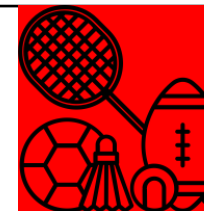




Objectives and Sticky Knowledge

 Know that zones help the game play.

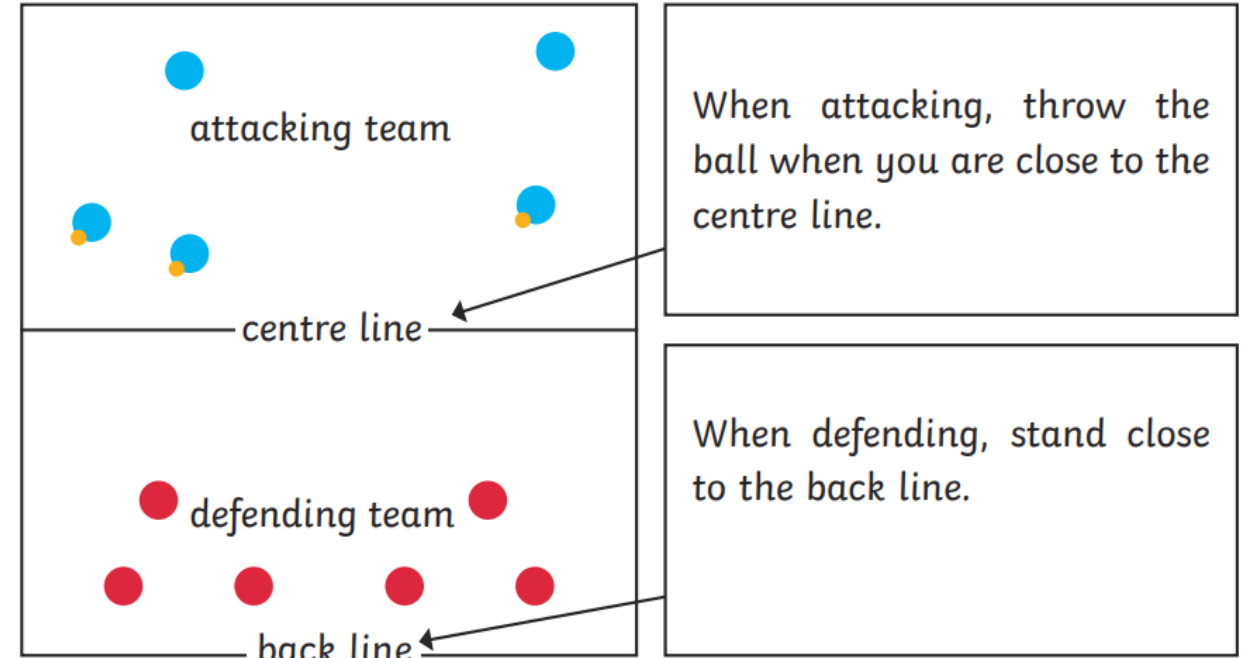
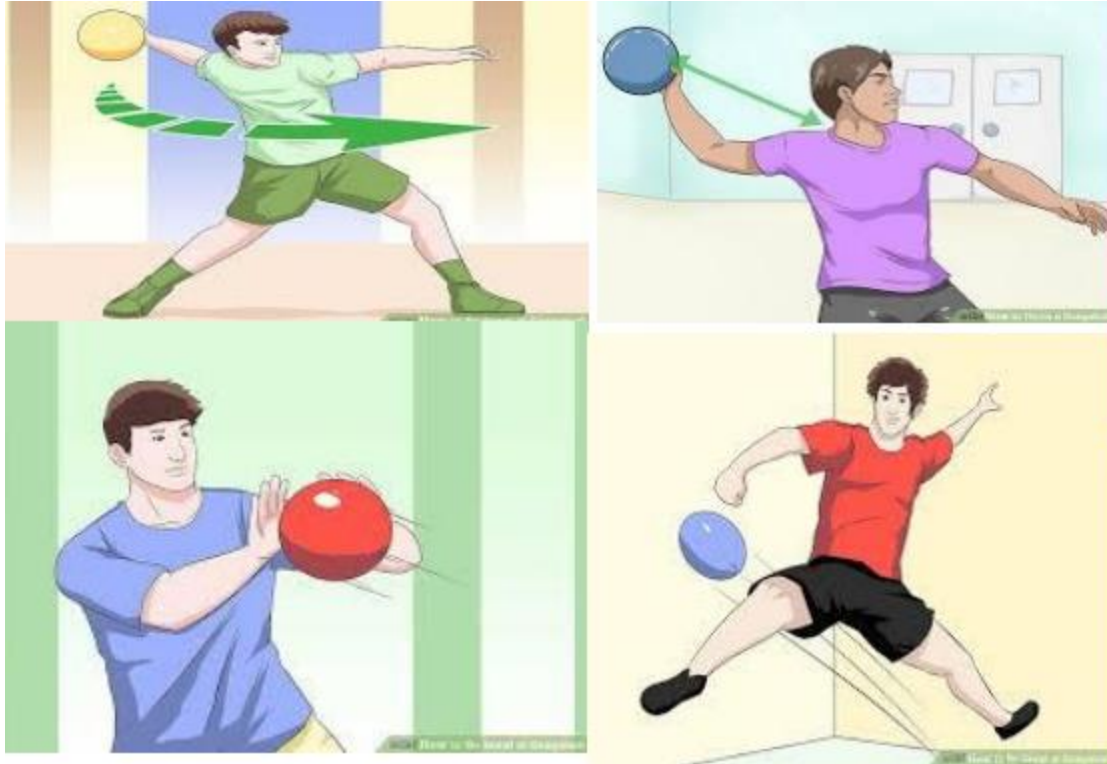


Be aware of space and use it to support team mates and cause problems for the opposition	To throw and catch with control when under limited pressure	To know how to use rules fairly to keep games going
