








Year 4 Music Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary

Vocals	The parts of the music that are sung.
Verse	A section of a song that often has the same melody but different words. Some songs can have several verses.
Beat	The steady pulse that keeps going through a piece of music and keeps you playing at a steady tempo. If the tempo changes during a piece of music, the pulse can speed up or slow down.
Unison	Playing or singing the same notes together at the same time.

2. Recall memorable phrases heard in the music and recognise major and minor tonality.

3. Start to use simple structures within compositions e.g. introduction, verse, chorus or AB form.
